



Dear citizens beginning the last week of September your construction debris and vegetative/tree debris will start to be picked up. The date will be more definite when it gets closer.

Building materials, carpet, drywall, lumber, etc. keep separate from other types of disaster debris. Place on road right-of-way without blocking roadway. Crews will be collecting this material over the next few weeks.

Tree branches, tree trunks, brush, etc. keep separate from other types of disaster debris. Cut tree debris into maximum 8 foot lengths and place on road right-of-way without blocking roadway. Crews will be collecting this material over the next few weeks.

Household trash and bagged debris of any kind will not be picked up with disaster debris. Continue to follow your normal garbage removal schedule.

Please remember to separate your construction debris from your vegetative/tree debris or you may be responsible for the cost of removal.

As things develop the city will inform you further in this matter. Thank you for your cooperation during this stressful time.
